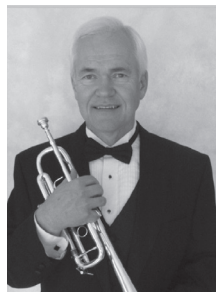


MARIANNA MALINKINE

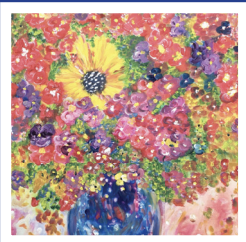
